Course Description: This is a three-day intensive, highly interactive advanced Scrum course designed for students who have already taken the Scrum Emersion or similar introductory course and spent several months attempting to implement Scrum. This is NOT an introductory course for beginners. Unlike most courses, it is different every time it is delivered because it begins with a potential of 50 different exercises. The exercises and lecture used in any particular class are defined by the class based upon an initial retrospective. This class is all about finding ways to make Scrum work within real organizations.

Course Objectives:

- Improve real-world Scrum implementations
- Provide greater understanding of core Scrum tools, practices and processes.
- Enhance the ability to successfully coach Scrum teams
- Improve the use of retrospectives
- Significantly improve Sprint output & forecasting
- Improve customer satisfaction.

Target Audience: This course is an advanced course designed for students who are already trained and practicing Agilists. Do NOT enroll in this course if you have not taken a previous Scrum course and spent at least three months working on a Scrum project.

Prerequisites: Students are required to have previously completed a basic Scrum course such as LGd's Scrum Emersion course.
